


Welcome to Teamwork!



Happy to Help Gateshead is an expert home help team, and we've been supporting people in their own homes for over 20 years.

We provide weekly cleaning, bill paying, shopping and prescription collection for older and disabled residents across the borough. We believe that every individual is different therefore we tailor our care packages to suit each households needs.

1-2-1 Assisted Outings

If you or your loved one want to go out and about but lack confidence to do so alone, we have trained, insured workers to offer an arm to lean on, some company and peace of mind.

The service is 1-2-1, flexible, and can be used for many different outings such as to go to an appointment, a trip to the shops, to take part in a leisure activity or attend a lunch club for instance.

It's a comforting way of helping our customers who want to retain their independence but need or want someone there to share the outing(s) with.

Low Cost Furniture for Households in Hardship

Our charity provides low cost, pre-loved furniture, electrical items and kitchen appliances to all Gateshead residents who are experiencing hardship for any reason.

Any Gateshead resident experiencing financial hardship, whatever their circumstances, is eligible to access support. Each household will receive 6 months access from their first visit too, which can be renewed as often as necessary.

We also supply a range of high quality, affordable beds and mattresses, in a range of styles and sizes. You do not have to be in hardship, or live in Gateshead to purchase our new items, and each item we sell raises vital funds to support our charity.

Delivery is available for all of our new and pre-loved goods.

We take payment via cash, card and secure telephone payment too.



Foundation-4-Work offers free work experience opportunities in a welcoming warehouse and retail setting where people gain many of the employability skills and references that employers are looking for.

In addition, we have free one to one support and small workshops to give you everything you need to feel ready and confident to seek work or become self employed. You can choose any of the support you feel you need:-

- Interview Skills
- CV Writing
- Online Job Searches
- Writing Application Forms
- Writing a CV

Placements last for up to 12 weeks, with just one day per week commitment required. Each participant leaves with their personal Foundation-4-Work toolkit along with a pair of work boots and high-vis vest, provided free of charge.

Each lunch club has great food (£7.50 for two, freshly cooked courses and refreshments), wonderful company, and plenty of activities, arts and crafts, games and quizzes. If there is something to be celebrated, you can guarantee that we will do it in style.

Our accessible, door to door minibus transport is £4 (price includes the journey home too) and is available from addresses in Teams, Dunston, Lobley Hill, Bensham, Saltwell and Central Gateshead.

For our attendees who can't make it to the centre due to illness or injury, we provide a hot meals delivery service while they recover at home.

Join us from mid morning to mid afternoon on Mondays or Thursdays (or both!) to relax, read the newspaper, join in with the banter, play games and share stories. There's always a warm welcome at our centre, on Bolam Street, Teams. We have all of the facilities available to ensure that our attendees have a great day out.

Our two course meals are £7.50 and they are prepared each day by our wonderful cooks. There's plenty of baked goods to take home too. Our regular attendees from the local area benefit from peace of mind when they are unable to come to the centre while recovering from illness or injury, as we will always deliver a hot meal to them at home if wanted.

If you live locally, why not use our accessible minibus. We can pick you up from your door, bring you to our centre and take you home again afterwards. Transport is £4 (price includes the journey home too). Transport is available in Teams, Bensham, Lobley Hill, Dunston, Saltwell and Central Gateshead.
